Class One - Clear Round

Jumps not to exceed 2'3ft. Open to horses and ponies and any rider.

Class Two - Pairs

Jumps will be between 2'3 and 2'6. Open to horses and ponies and any rider.

Class Three - Novice

Jumps not to exceed 2'6ft. Horse/Pony not to have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any cross country competition.

Class Four - Open

Jumps not to exceed 2'9ft. Open to any horse or pony and any rider.

Classes two and three will be split into Junior and Senior sections if entries are sufficient. Classes to be run to an optimum time which will be announced on the day after the class. Winner of the class will be the combination to be clear and closest to the optimum time. **Please note that this event forms part of the Essex Rider League sponsored by Bedsoft. Therefore, the highest place horses and ponies in each class will be awarded points for this league.**

Entry Fees:

Class 1 – Members £4.00 Non-Members £6.00

Class 2, 3 & 4 – Members £6.00 Non-Members £10.00

There is a £2.00 first aid levy payable by each rider.

ENTRIES:

There will be a limit of 35 competitors in each class. Postal entries close on Friday 30th April. If classes is not full entries will be welcomed on the day.

Entries on the day will be subject to a fee of £2.00 extra per class.

RULES:

- 1. The competition will be run under British Riding Club Rules.**
- 2. Entries will be limited and will be accepted according to postmark.**
- 3. Entries will not be refunded after the closing date without the production of a valid Doctors or Vets Certificate.**
- 4. £5.00 refundable deposit required for all numbers.**
- 5. Competitors must be responsible for the control of their animals and liable for vets expenses on the day.**
- 6. All competitors must be dressed correctly. Riding hats must be secured and fastened**

properly and comply with BSEN 4472/6473 or BSEND 1384 or PAS 015, as recommended by British Riding Clubs. Body Protectors to BETA standard must be worn at all times along with a medical armband.

7. Reckless riding or unruly behaviour, bad language or aggression to any of the judges, stewards, other competitors will not be tolerated and will result in IMMEDIATE ELIMINATION with no right of appeal.
8. Horses and ponies may only compete three classes during the competition.
9. The committee reserve the right to refuse entry, alter or cancel any class without giving a reason.
10. Any objection (Apart from rule seven) must be made within 30 minutes of any incident, together with a £20.00 deposit, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
11. ALL DOGS TO BE KEPT ON LEADS.
12. SDRC committee, the judge, officials and stewards accept no responsibility for any loss or damage to property to competitors, grooms or spectators. All riders ride at their own risk.
13. THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.
